


RRS Discovery and Discovery Point

Scotland's Jute Museum @ Verdant Works

Verdant Works is a tale of two cities - both of them Dundee. Experience what thousands of people who worked in the jute mills during 19th century Dundee endured, whilst for the privileged few - the Jute Barons, it was a city of opportunity and wealth. At Verdant Works the rattle and roar of the original, restored machinery will transport you back over 100 years to an era when jute was king and Dundee was its realm. Entry fee includes a chance to view the recently restored High Mill and exhibitions.
